Tuesday, April 23, 2:00pm Display and short documentary of the St. John's Bible Saint John's Bible is the first illuminated, handwritten Bible commissioned by a Benedictine Monastery in 500 years. It was created in a partnership of Saint John's Abbey and University with Donald Jackson, Senior Scribe to the British Crown. It took ten years to complete from 2000 to 2010.

The Heritage Edition, which we will be bringing, is a full-scale, fine art edition of The Saint John's Bible. Each page of the Heritage Edition was color-matched to the original manuscript. There are 299 Heritage Editions distributed globally. The purpose of The Saint John's Bible is to ignite the spiritual imagination of people of all faith journeys around the world through the illuminations. In our time together, we will discuss the history and making of The Saint John's Bible, and then practice the process of Visio Divina using a few illuminations from the Bible to ignite the spiritual imagination of the participants.
